Module 1: Understanding the history of colonization, colonialism, race and racialization on Canadian society.

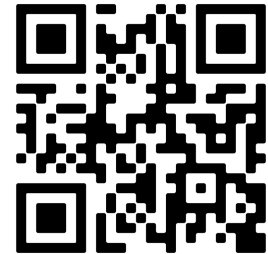
Module 2: The impacts of colonization, colonialism, race and racialization on the Canadian education system.
